

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTION

ARAPAHO & ROOSEVELT NATIONAL FORESTS  
PAWNEE NATIONAL GRASSLAND

Pursuant to Title 16, United States Code, § 551, 36 CFR, § 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest. The Restricted Area includes all National Forest System lands from State Highway 7 south to Boulder Canyon Drive (State Highway 119) and from the Peak to Peak Highway (State Highway 72) east to the Roosevelt National Forest boundary. The Restricted Area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to protect life due to hazards from the Fourmile Canyon Fire.

PROHIBITED ACT:

1. Being on National Forest System lands in the Restricted Area 36 CFR Section 261.53(e & f).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR. Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this ORDER:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing this prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Homeowners accessing their private property.
4. News media reporting on the Fourmile Canyon Fires.

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or until midnight December 31, 2010, whichever comes first.
