

**ORDER NO. 10-D3-05**

**NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS & TRAILS**  
**CLEARWATER NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on Osier Ridge Trail 429 and Pollock Ridge Trail 478, within the North Fork Ranger District of the Clearwater National Forest, from date of signing until rescinded

1. Being on the trail. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

This restriction applies to any use on the following National Forest System Trail:

**Osier Ridge Trail 429:** From the junction of Osier Ridge Lookout Road 737-B at Osier Lookout to the junction with Pollock Ridge Trail 478 at Wapito Point. [T40N, R11E, S12 to T40N, R12E, S22].

**Pollock Ridge Trail 478:** From the junction of Deception Saddle Road 255 and Osier Creek to the junction with Osier Ridge Trail 429 at Wapito Point. [T39N, R11E, S4 to T40N, R12E, S22].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Forest Service administrative traffic.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

The above restrictions are necessary for PUBLIC SAFETY due to fire activity in vicinity.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
