Request for Concept Papers

The Lassen County Resource Advisory Committee announces round nine of requests for concept papers for use of funding in 2011 provided by the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act (PL 110-343).

Funds may be used for projects on National Forest land. Examples of eligible projects include:

- Watershed restoration
- Road and trail maintenance
- Wildlife and fish habitat improvement
- Control of noxious and exotic weeds
- Soil productivity improvement
- Improvement in forest ecosystem health
- Re-establishment of native species.

Funds may also be used on adjacent private lands so long as the project benefits the adjoining National Forest land. Projects which leverage the funds with in-kind and cash matching funds are highly encouraged. Projects must be located within Lassen County.

Eligibility: Communities, organizations, tribes, and government agencies are eligible for funding.
