The National Urban and Community Forestry Advisory Council focuses on the present health and future preservation of America's urban treescapes. An important way the Council can fulfill its vision and make a positive impact on community forests nationwide, both now and in the future, is through its annual challenge cost-share program. Grant categories include:

- Research and Technology Development (examine the effects of urban and community forest resources on human development, experience, and behavior, as well as the effects of human activities on trees and community forests);
- Education, Communication and Outreach (increase the public's understanding of the value of the urban and community forest, and responsibility for its health); and
- Creative and Innovative Projects (support creative and innovative urban forestry ideas, stimulate the development of additional funding for urban forestry through private sector support and local investments, and cultivate private sector partnerships that leverage investments of human and financial resources).
