

**AREA RESTRICTION
BEAVERHEAD-DEERLODGE and BITTERROOT NATIONAL FORESTS
ANACONDA-PINTLER WILDERNESS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited in the Area described in this order within the Beaverhead-Deerlodge and Bitterroot National Forests until further notice.

SELF ISSUED MANDATORY REGISTRATION


All persons entering into the Anaconda-Pintler Wilderness Area are required to fill out a self-issued mandatory registration card. The person's City, County and State or residence is required information. Name and street address is optional information. (Title 36 CFR 261.57 (a)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


Location description – This restriction includes all National Forest lands within the boundaries of the Anaconda-Pintler Wilderness Area located on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge and Bitterroot National Forests.
