

ORDER NO.: 2001-BD/BITT- 02

**AREA RESTRICTION  
BEAVERHEAD-DEERLODGE and BITTERROOT NATIONAL FORESTS  
ANACONDA-PINTLER WILDERNESS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the Area described in this order within the Beaverhead-Deerlodge and Bitterroot National Forests until further notice.

**CAMPING WITH STOCK**

It is prohibited to camp with pack and riding stock within ¼ mile of the following lakes: (Title 36 CFR 261.58 (s) and Title 36 CFR 261.57 (b)).

Sawed Cabin Lake  
Oreamnos Lake  
Ripple Lake

**TRAVEL WITH STOCK**

Possessing or using a saddle, pack or draft animal on the Hope Lake Trail #424. (Title 36 CFR 261.55 (c). (Reason: Trail unsafe for stock and no appropriate area to contain stock in the vicinity of the lake.)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**Location description** – This restriction includes all National Forest lands within the boundaries of the Anaconda-Pintler Wilderness Area located on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge and Bitterroot National Forests.


