Forest Supervisor's Order

Pursuant to title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited as described below, on the Bitterroot National Forest. This prohibition is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect until rescinded.

- 1. Persons are prohibited from possessing, storing or transporting marijuana on National Forest System Land [Title 36 CFR 261.58(t)].**

The purpose of this prohibition is for public safety.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer in the performance of an official duty.
