

## USE OF COMO SWIM BEACH

Order of the Forest Supervisor

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.53, the following acts are prohibited in the area described in this order on the Darby Ranger District, Bitterroot National Forest.

Possession of glass containers in the following area.

SWIM AREALOCATION

Lake Como Swim Area  
North Shore of Lake Como.

From the Como Dam spillway, west approximately 300 yards to the end of the sandy beaches; and between the designated parking area at the swim area to the lake shore.

S.E.1/4, S.E.1/4, Sec. 29, T.4 N., R.21 W.

This restriction is necessary to provide for public health and safety.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
