Travel Management Restriction on Trail 674

WEST FORK R.D.

The Travel Management Restriction for Overwhich Trail 674 in Forest Supervisor Order Dated June 29, 1992 is hereby rescinded and replaced by this Order.

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on Overwhich Trail 674.

Overwhich	674	From gate in NE ¼ Section 20, T2S, R21W to Trail 182	3.5 miles


Using any motorized vehicle on the road (36 CFR 261.54(a), or trail (36 CFR 261.55(b) from October 15 to December 1.

Using a Jeep or highway vehicle yearlong.

Temporary exceptions are authorized to the above listed controls for any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty, and any vehicle whose use is expressly authorized by the Forest Service under a permit, license or contract (36 CFR 261.50 (e)).

The yearlong restriction was placed on the trail after debris slides closed the trail. The trail was repaired across the debris slides but the restriction was not rescinded. This order implements the seasonal travel restriction on the trail that existed prior to the debris slides.
