

ORDER

By virtue of the authority vested in me under the Regulation of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 CFR 261.50, the following ROAD and TRAIL on the Bitterroot National Forest are designated to be used under the rules listed below:

<u>ROAD NAME (Location)</u>	<u>ROAD NO.</u>	<u>TERMINI</u>	<u>LENGTH</u>
Southside Overwhich	5700	From Road 5699 in SW SW Section 13, T2S, R22W, to end of road in NE SW Section 21, T2S, R21W.	6.2 miles

Resind this from Overwhich 6/29

<u>TRAIL NO.</u>	<u>TERMINI</u>	<u>LENGTH</u>
674	From gate in NE 1/4, Section 20, T2S, R21W to Trail 182.	3.5 miles

The following act is prohibited on Road 5700 and Trail 674 yearlong:

Using any motorized vehicle on the road (36 CFR 261.54(a)), or trail (36 CFR 261.55(b)).

Temporary exceptions are authorized to the above listed controls for any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty, and any vehicle whose use is expressly authorized by the Forest Service under a permit, license or contract (36 CFR 261.50(e)).

This restriction is to provide for public safety due to debris slides and erosion at stream channels.
