

ORDER

By virtue of the authority vested in me under the Regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 CFR 261.54, the following roads on the Bitterroot National Forest on the West Fork Ranger District are designated to be used as follows:

Lookout Mtn. North	No. 5699	From junction with Road No. 5700 in SW 1/4 of Section 13, T2S, R22W, to the end of the Road in N 1/2 of Section 25, T2S, R22W.
Southside Overwhich	No. 5700 <i>Supervisor's 6/27/90 order closes rd 5700 to all motorized vehicles</i>	From junction with Road No. 5699 in SW 1/4 of Section 13, T2S, R22W, to the end of the road in SW 1/4 of Section 21, T2S, R21W. <i>Covered</i>

The ORDER signed February 26, 1990 by the Forest Supervisor restricting motorized vehicle use either seasonally or yearlong to certain vehicles on the above listed roads is rescinded (for the above listed roads only) and is replaced by this ORDER.

Using any motorized vehicle over 40 inches in total width is immediately PROHIBITED yearlong, until this order is rescinded or revoked. This restriction is to prevent removal of firewood in the Overwhich Fire Salvage sale area. Dead trees in the burn area are needed to provide shade for regeneration on the harsh site.

Temporary exceptions are authorized to the above-listed restrictions for any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty, and any vehicle whose use is expressly authorized by the Forest Service under a permit, license, or contract (36 CFR 261.50(e)).
