

ORDER

By virtue of the authority vested in me under the Regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 CFR 261.50, the following area on the Bitterroot National Forest is designated to be used under the rules listed below:

ALL BITTERROOT NATIONAL FOREST AREA WITHIN IDAHO

Rules

Possessing or transporting any part of a tree or plant is prohibited [36 CFR 261.58 (t)].

Exceptions:

1. Possessing or transporting nonwoody plants for individuals making personal, noncommercial collections.
2. Campers and wilderness users possessing firewood for heating and cooking use within the area.
3. Forest Service administrative use requiring transport and possession of firewood for use at field camps and guard stations.
