AMENDMENT 5

A NEPA analysis has been made, and it was determined that this amendment is not a significant change in the National Forests in Mississippi Land and Resource Management plan; nor does it alter the multiple use goals and objectives for long-term land and resource management.

The Homochitto Management Area Standards and Guidelines, Pine-Hardwood Working Group, page 4-147 of the Forest Plan, is amended to clarify that while no net increase or decrease is anticipated in the pine-hardwood forest type, the actual determination will be made based on soils information and interpretation, not on the basis of an increase or decrease in net acreage.
