Amendments #9 through 16

Amendment #9 – Strong River Ranger District – Compartment 269 Uneven-aged Management Demonstration Project

Amendment #10 – Designation of Research Natural Areas: Granny Creek Bay Proposed Research Natural Area (120 acres) and Nutmeg Hickory Proposed Research Natural Area (299 acres). Also includes pen and ink acreage changes.

Amendment #11 – Limits of Acceptable Change for Black Creek and Leaf Wilderness Areas and Black Creek Wild and Scenic River Corridor.

Amendment #12 – Change in allocation to Not Suitable 2 Management Prescription. Implementation of Special Use Permit FEIS for Military Training Activities on National Forest administered lands.

Amendment #13 – Incorporation of Chief’s Policy Memos of June 4 and June 25, 1992 on ecosystem management. Utilization of uneven-aged system for demonstration projects.

Amendment #14 – Designation of tentative Habitat Management Areas (HMAs) for suitable RCW habitat.

Amendment #15 – Change in allocation to Not Suitable 2 Management Prescription. Implementation of Supplement Number 1 to SUP-FEIS on final site selection of proposed G. V. (Sonny) Montgomery Range at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Amendment #16 – Provides direction for the preparation of site-specific Biological Evaluations (BEs) including inventory requirements for Proposed, Endangered, Threatened, and Sensitive (PETS) species for the National Forests in Mississippi. Changes wording in portions of the Mississippi National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan, Amendment #6 (Exhibit F – Record of Decision – Vegetation Management – Coastal Plain/Piedmont), January 1989.
