Description

Located adjacent to the Shockaloe National Recreation Horse Trail, this recreation area provides parking, camping, and picnicking for trail riders and other users. The area is in a delightful "piney woods" setting. Nearby Raworth Tank (pond) supplied water for stream locomotives in days past. Facilities include 10 camping sites (no hook-ups), picnic tables, one group pavilion, hitching rails, drinking water, and vault toilets. Shockaloe is open year round unless weather conditions require the area to be closed. Shockaloe Base Camp I is a fee area. The fee station is located just beyond the entrance gate. No attendant will be on duty. Therefore, users should make sure that they have correct currency before arriving at the recreation area.

The following daily rates apply:

Day Use - Free

Camping - \$7.00, (per vehicle)

Passes Honored - Access and Senior

Passes can only be purchased at the District Ranger's Office.

Discounts:

Camping - \$3.50, (Users with Access and Senior honor passes receive a 50% discount.)

Located adjacent to the Shockaloe National Recreation Horse Trail northwest of Forest, MS.

Directions

From Forest, take HWY 80 west for four miles. Turn right (north) on Forest Service Road 513 and go a 1/4 mile to the signed recreation entrance.
