Description

Shockaloe is a National Recreation Trail that winds 23 miles through much of the northern half of the Bienville National Forest. The trails takes the rider through varying terrains and vegetation types. The trail crosses Forest Service roads at several points and rides of different length can be planned. Shockaloe Base Camp I offer riders camping and picnicking opportunities. Shockaloe Base II has 5 pull-through parking spaces and one group pavilion for riders. Shockaloe Horse Trail is open year round unless weather conditions require the area to be closed. No user fees required.

Location

Located northwest of Forest, MS.

Directions

From Forest, take HWY 80 west for four miles. Turn right (north) on Forest Service Road 513 and go to the signed entrance for Shockaloe Base Camps.

Accessibility

There are no access ramps provided within parking areas.
