ORDER NO. 05-50-194

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the LAKE WEDINGTON RECREATION AREA within the Ozark-St. Francis National Forests, until further notice.

The following prohibited acts are set forth in 36 C.F.R. 261.58

261.58(k) Swimming or being in the water outside the designated swim area.

261.58(n) Possessing or operating a motorboat in such a manner that it is an impediment or hazard to the safety and convenience of any person.

261.58(n) Operating a motorboat with a excess of 10 H.P. Boats equipped with motors larger than 10 H.P. must have the motor disabled prior to launching the boat by one of the following methods:

1. Complete removal of the propeller.
2. Removal of the fuel line from the boat.
3. Removal of at least one (1) spark plug, or spark plug wire from the boat.

261.58(n) Operating a motorboat in such a manner as to create an excessive wake.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty with approval of District Ranger.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

This order will expire five (5) years after the date of execution.
