


RESERVATIONS - National Recreation Reservation System (NRRS) at 1-877-444-6777 or at www.recreation.gov. Web reservation fees are \$9 per site, non-refundable. Call center reservations are \$10 per site, non-refundable. Reservations can be made only for the summer recreation season. Reservation can be made up to six months in advance for individual campsites and 12 months in advance for group campsites. Some sites may require two or three nights of minimum stay on weekends and holidays.

CAMPSITES – Single: 6 people, 2 vehicles. Double: 12 people, 4 vehicles. Open and closing dates are subject to change. Call for exact dates.

RECREATION PASSES are available at local vendors or any Forest Service office. Check the forest website for a listing of local vendors. Forest Service offices accept cash or check payment. Credit cards are accepted at some vendors.

- Annual passes expire December 31 of the year purchased; 1-day and 3-day passes expire at noon on the day after the last day of the pass.
- Any motorized vehicle or motorcycle that occupies a space in a fee area listed here and/or signed as a fee area is required to display a pass.
- No refunds.



PAY AT SITE FEES - Payment envelopes are provided at sites that require fees to be deposited at the recreation site. Accepted payments are cash or check. Change is not available. State and local taxes apply to some fee areas.

CUMBERLAND RANGER DISTRICT – Cave Run Lake area

Boat Ramps - Alfrey, Claylick, Poppin Rock, Longbow, Scott Creek, and Warix. Open all year. (Warix closed December 1 to April 4). Buy pass at vendor or District Office. \$3/1-day; \$5/3-day; \$30/annual. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*. The discount may be obtained only when purchasing at a District Office. Only one annual pass may be purchased with pass discount.

Claylick Boat-in Campground - Open all year. Pay at site. April 30 to October 4: \$12/night/site, \$6/boat for day use; October 5 to April 29: \$10/night/site.

Clear Creek Campground - Pay at site. April 9 to October 29: \$12/single site, \$18/double site. October 30 to November 29: \$10/single site, \$14/double site. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*.

Clear Creek Shooting Range - Open all year. Pay at site. April 9 to October 29: \$6 for up to 5 persons/vehicle. \$1 additional person or walk-in. October 30 to April 8: \$5 for up to 5 persons/vehicle. \$1 additional person or walk-in.

Twin Knobs Campground – Open March 12 to November 1. Pay at entrance station. \$20 single; \$30 double. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*. Sites in loops C, G, H and I may be reserved** through NRRS. Checks, Visa, MasterCard and American Express accepted. Pass discounts* do not apply to hookups or additional fees. Hookup fees per RV/night: electric \$5; sewer/water/electric \$7. RV dump station \$6/use. Site changes after 1 change \$5. Extra vehicle \$8/night. Day use: up to 5 persons/vehicle \$6; walk-in/bicycle \$1/ person. Annual day use/family \$55. Interpretive programs \$5/vehicle. Firewood \$6. Campground information at 1-606-784-8816.

Twin Knobs Group Use Areas - Open March 12 to November 1. Reserve through NRRS. East Area: 100 person capacity \$75/day or night. West Area: 180 person capacity \$95/day. Tent Area: 60 person capacity \$55/night.

Boat Gunnel Group Use Area - Open April 9 to October 18. Reserve through NRRS. 100 person capacity, \$95/day.

* Pass types honored for discount: America the Beautiful Senior & Access Passes, Golden Age Passport and Golden Access Passport.



** Twin Knobs and Zilpo recreation areas are operated by Recreation Resource Management. Twin Knobs Group Use Areas may be reserved up to 12 months in advance. Campsites in Twin Knobs C, G, H, and I loops may be reserved up to 6 months in advance and no less than 5 days in advance. Several sites in Zilpo may also be reserved.

CUMBERLAND RANGER DISTRICT – Cave Run Lake area

Zilpo Campground** - Open April 9 to October 18. Pay at entrance station. Some sites may be reserved through NRRS. \$20 single; \$30 double. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*. Checks, Visa, MasterCard and American Express accepted. Pass discounts* do not apply to hookups or additional fees. Hookup fees per RV/night: electric \$5; sewer/water/electric \$7; RV dump station \$6/use. Other fees: site changes after 1 change \$5; extra vehicle \$8/night; day use up to 5 persons/vehicle \$6; walk-in/bicycle \$1/person. Annual day use/family \$55. Interpretive programs \$5/vehicle. Firewood \$6. Campground information at 1-606-768-2722.

Zilpo Cabin - Up to 7 persons/vehicle. May be reserved through NRRS. \$55/night. Open April 9 to October 18.

Twin Knobs Amphitheater - Reserve through NRRS. \$75 per group/day.

Twin Knobs & Zilpo Beaches - Open May 14 to August 30. Pay at entrance station. Visitor day use \$5/car load. Over 5 per car: \$1/person. Walk-in/bicycle \$1/person. Commercial buses/vans over 15 people: \$1/person. Annual pass for beach use \$55. Open 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

White Sulphur Horse Camp - Open all year. Pay at site. April 9 to October 29: camping \$12 per night per vehicle; day use \$6/day. October 30 to April 8: camping \$10 per vehicle per night; day use \$6/day.

White Sulphur Trail - OHVs 50 inches or less. Open April 30 to November 29. Buy pass at vendor or District Office. \$7/day; \$15/3 days; \$40/annual. Pass discounts* do not apply. \$20 annual youth pass for persons under the age of 16 may be purchased at District Office. Proof of ATV safety training and parental supervision is required.

CUMBERLAND RANGER DISTRICT – Red River Gorge area

Backcountry Camping in Red River Gorge/Indian Creek - Open all year. Buy permit at vendor, Gladie Center or District Office. All vehicles on KY 15 or in the Red River Gorge and Indian Creek areas north of KY 15 must display a permit between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. \$3/day; \$5/3 days; \$30/annual. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*. The 50% discount for these sites may be obtained only by purchasing the permit at a District Office. Only one annual permit may be purchased with a pass discount.

Koomer Ridge Campground - Open all year. Pay at site. April 9 to October 29: \$18/single, \$22/double campsite. \$8 extra vehicle per night. October 30 to April 8: \$10/site. Drinking water and vault toilets are available all year. Showers and flush toilets are not available during the winter. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*.

LONDON RANGER DISTRICT

Laurel River Lake Boat Ramps - Flatwoods, Grove, Holly Bay, Marsh Branch, and Laurel Bridge. Open all year. Buy pass at vendor or Ranger Station. \$3/1 day; \$5/3 days; \$30/annual. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*. The 50% discount for these sites may be obtained only by purchasing the pass at a District Office. Only one annual pass may be purchased with a pass discount.

Grove & Holly Bay Campgrounds, Drive-In Sites - Open April 9 to October 17. Pay at entrance station. \$24/single; \$29/premium single; \$44 double; \$49/premium double. Fee includes hookup surcharge. Interagency Pass discounts honored for camping fee. Trailer dump \$7/use for non-campers. \$6/extra camper vehicle.

Grove Campground, Loop B Drive-In Sites - Open April 9 to October 17. Reserve through NRRS from May 21 to September 6. Available on a first-come, first-served basis before and after season, or during reservation season if the site has not been reserved by another party. Fees same as Grove & Holly Bay above.

Holly Bay Campground, Loops D & H Drive-In Sites - Open April 9 to October 17. Reserve through NRRS from May 21 to September 6. Available on a first-come, first-served basis before and after season, or during reservation season if the site has not been reserved by another party. Fees same as Grove & Holly Bay above.

Grove & Holly Bay Campgrounds, Walk-In - Open April 9 to October 17. Pay at site. \$14 single site, up to 6 people; \$22 double site at Holly Bay, up to 12 people. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*.

Grove & White Oak Boat-In Campgrounds - Open all year. Pay at site. \$14 single, up to 6 people; \$22 double, up to 12 people. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*.

Craigs Creek Group Use Area - Open April 9 to October 17. Reserve through NRRS. Site B/\$80, up to 30 people; Site C/\$110, up to 60 people. Picnic Shelter/\$80, up to 60 people. Site A is closed.

Bee Rock Campground - Open April 10 to October 25. Pay at site. \$8/single site; \$12/double site. Laurel County side is open all year. 50% discount with Interagency Pass*.

STEARNS RANGER DISTRICT

Natural Arch Scenic Area - Open all year. Pay at site. \$3/day; \$5/3 days; \$30 annual. Purchase annual pass at vendor or District Office. Free use with Interagency or Golden Pass. Display Interagency or Golden Pass* on vehicle dash to receive free use discount. Two picnic shelters and an amphitheater are available for group rental at \$25/day each. Call the District Office at 1-606-376-5323. Unless rented, these facilities are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Keno Shooting Range - Open all year. Pay at site \$3/day; \$5/3 days; \$30 annual. Purchase annual pass at vendor or District Office. Interagency Pass/Golden Passport discounts do not apply.

Barren Fork Horse Camp - Open April 1 to November 15. Pay at site. \$8/day/site, \$12/2 days/site, \$100 annual. Purchase annual pass at District Office. The 50% discount* for these sites may be obtained only by purchasing the pass at a District Office. Only one annual pass may be purchased with discount.

Barren Fork Picnic Shelter - Open April 1 to November 15. Rent picnic shelter for \$25/day. Contact District Office at 1-606-376-5323. Unless rented, the shelter is available on first-come, first-served basis.

Appletree Shooting Range - Open all year. Pay at site. \$3/day, \$5/3 days, \$30 annual. Purchase annual pass at vendor or District Office. Interagency Pass/Golden Passport discounts do not apply.

Hemlock Grove Picnic Shelter - Open all year. Rent shelter for \$25/day. Contact District Office at 606-376-5323. Unless rented, the shelter is available on first-come, first-served basis.

Alpine Picnic Shelter - Open April 1 to Oct. 31. Rent shelter for \$25/day. Contact District Office at 606-376-5323. Unless rented, the shelter is available on first-come, first-served basis.

REDBIRD RANGER DISTRICT

Redbird Crest Trail - OHVs 50 inches or less. Open all year. Buy pass at vendor or District Office. \$7/day; \$15/3 days; \$40/annual. \$20 annual youth pass for persons under the age of 16 may be purchased at District Office. Proof of ATV safety training and parental supervision is required.

Gladie Center/Gladie Historic Site. Open all year. During the main recreation season (from mid-March to mid-November) the Center is open 7 days a week from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. During the winter season (mid-November to mid-March) the Center is open Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Grays Arch, Sky Bridge, Rock Bridge - Open all year.

Cottage Furnace – April 2 to October 29.

Red River Gorge Scenic Byway, overlooks and trailheads - Open all year.

Fitchburg Furnace - Closed for repairs

Red River Canoe Launches - Big Branch, Copperas Creek, Red River. Open all year.

LONDON RANGER DISTRICT

Picnic Areas - Baldrock, Laurel Bridge, S-Tree, Flatwoods. Open all year.

Turkey Foot Picnic Area - Open April 10 to November 24.

Camp Wildcat Civil War Historical Site - Open all year.

Laurel Lake Boat Ramps - Craigs Creek and Hightop. Open all year.

Upper Lake Cumberland Boat Ramps - Mouth of Laurel, Rockcastle, and Bee Rock. Open all year.

Rockcastle Campground (London Dock) - Open mid-May to end of September. Call District Office for exact dates.

Turkey Foot Campground - Open April 10 to November 23.

S-Tree Campground - Sites 1-10: open April 10 to October 26. Sites 11-20: open all year.

Fishing Sites - Fishing Point Road, Long Bend Road. Open all year.

Whitman Branch Shooting Range - Open all year.

Little Lick Campground - Open all year.

STEARNS RANGER DISTRICT

Bell Farm Horse Camp - Open April 1 to November 30.

Great Meadow Campground - (No water November 1 to April 15 at either loop.) Raccoon loop: open all year. Deer loop: closed October 31 to April 23.

Hemlock Grove Picnic Area - Open all year.

Overlooks - Great Gulf, Parkers Mountain. Open all year.

Alpine Picnic Area - Open April 1 to October 31.

Beaver Creek Wilderness - Open all year.

Sawyer Boat Ramp - Open all year. Toilet open April 1 to October 31.

Noes Boat Ramp - Closed due to low lake levels.

REDBIRD RANGER DISTRICT

Big Double and Cawood Picnic Sites - Open April 1 to October 31.

America the Beautiful – National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass Program

This interagency pass program provides reduced rates for frequent visitors to federal recreation areas. The program includes the Forest Service, National Park Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Bureau of Land Management, and Bureau of Reclamation. The following passports may be purchased at Forest Service District Offices or at the Supervisor's Office in Winchester, Ky.

Annual Pass - \$80

This pass is available for purchase by the general public, providing access to and use of federal recreation sites at no additional charge where an entrance fee or "standard amenity fee" is required. The pass is valid for one year from the date of purchase. At per vehicle fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder and their passengers in a non-commercial vehicle. At per person fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder plus three adults, not to exceed four adults; children under 16 are admitted free. The pass may be obtained in person at a Forest Service office or online at <http://store.usgs.gov/pass/index.html>. On the Daniel Boone National Forest, the Annual Pass is valid only at the National Arch Scenic Area on the Stearns Ranger District.

Senior Pass - \$10

This is a lifetime pass (and one-time purchase) for U.S. citizens or permanent residents age 62 or over. This pass provides access to and use of federal recreation sites that charge an entrance fee or "standard amenity fee." At per vehicle fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder and their passengers in a non-commercial vehicle. At per person fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder plus three adults, not to exceed four adults; children under 16 are admitted free.

This pass must be obtained in person at a participating federal agency office. The Senior Pass provides a 50 percent discount on some "expanded amenity fees" charged for facilities and services such as camping, swimming, boat launching, and specialized interpretive services. In some cases where expanded amenity fees are charged per person, only the pass holder will be given the 50 percent price reduction. The pass is non-transferable and generally does NOT cover or reduce special recreation permit fees or fees charged by concessionaires. On the Daniel Boone National Forest, the Senior Pass provides a 50% discount at developed boat ramps and at some developed camping facilities (see table below). Backcountry camping in the Red River Gorge is also discounted. The discount does not apply to utility hookup fees at campgrounds.

Access Pass - Free

This is a lifetime pass for U.S. citizens or permanent residents with permanent disabilities. Documentation is required to obtain the pass. Acceptable documentation includes: statement by a licensed physician; document issued by a federal agency such as the Veteran's Administration, Social Security Disability Income or Supplemental Security Income; or document issued by a state agency such as a vocational rehabilitation agency. The pass provides access to and use of federal recreation sites that charge an entrance or standard amenity fee. At per vehicle fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle. At per person fee areas, the pass admits the pass holder plus three adults, not to exceed four adults; children under 16 are admitted free.

This pass must be obtained in person at a participating federal agency office. The Access Pass provides a 50 percent discount on some expanded amenity fees charged for facilities and services such as camping, swimming, boat launching, and specialized interpretive services. In some cases, where expanded amenity fees are charged, only the pass holder will be given the 50 percent price reduction. The pass is non-transferable and generally does NOT cover or reduce special recreation permit fees or fees charged by concessionaires. On the Daniel Boone National Forest, the Access Pass provides a 50% discount at developed boat ramps and at some developed camping facilities (see table below). Backcountry camping in the Red River Gorge is also discounted. The discount does not apply to utility hookup fees at campgrounds.

Volunteer Pass – Free

This pass is for volunteers acquiring 500 service hours on a cumulative basis. It provides access to and use of federal recreation sites that charge an entrance fee or standard amenity fee. It is valid for one year from the date of award. The pass admits the pass holder and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle at per vehicle fee areas and the pass holder plus three adults, not to exceed four adults, at per person fee areas; children under 16 are admitted free. On the Daniel Boone National Forest, the Volunteer Pass is valid only at the National Arch Scenic Area on the Stearns Ranger District.

Former pass program passes:

All National Parks Passes, Golden Eagle, Golden Eagle Hologram, Golden Access and Golden Age Passports will continue to be honored according to the provisions of the pass. Only paper Golden Age and Access Passports may be exchanged free of charge for new plastic passes.

America the Beautiful – National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass Program

This interagency pass program provides reduced rates for frequent visitors to federal recreation areas. The following passports may be purchased at Forest Service District Offices or at the Supervisor's Office in Winchester, Ky.

Former pass program passes:

All National Parks Passes, Golden Eagle, Golden Eagle Hologram, Golden Access and Golden Age Passports will continue to be honored according to the provisions of the pass. Only paper Golden Age and Access Passports may be exchanged free of charge for new plastic passes.
