Snowmobile trail map available at Forest Service office

(Walden, Colo.) Dec. 3, 2010 – The Parks Ranger District is offering a free map showing ungroomed and groomed snowmobile trails in the Gould area. The map shows open winter trails on the Routt National Forest and on Colorado State Forest State Park, including a short detour for the popular Silver Creek trail connection across the National Forest between the winter parking area south of Gould and the State Park.

The snowmobile trail over Calamity Pass and the trail over Illinois Pass will not be open this winter due to hazard tree removal work on Forest Roads 740, 760, 770, 758, and 750. The closure is for public safety since logging operations and snowmobiling are not compatible uses on forest roads.
