



PUBLIC NOTICE
Tahoe National Forest
French Meadows Restricted Use Area
ORDER NO. 17-95-169

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Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), I prohibit all of the following acts on National Forest lands outside of developed recreation sites in the French Meadows Restricted Use Area as shown on Exhibit 1:

1. Camping. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
2. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

The exterior boundaries of the French Meadows Restricted Use Area as shown on Exhibit 1; generally described as:

Beginning at the Middle Fork of the American River, approximately ½ mile downstream of the French Meadows Dam (Section line common to Sec. 35, & Sec. 36, T.15 N., R. 13 E., MDM.) Proceed southerly along said section line to the Forest Boundary. Then proceed easterly along the Forest Boundary to the top of Chipmunk Ridge. Then proceed northeasterly along Chipmunk Ridge to Section 23, T.15 N., R. 14 E., MDM. Then north along the section lines common to Sections 22 & 23, 13 & 14, 11 & 12, 1 & 2, stopping at the Third Standard Parallel. Then westerly along the Third Standard Parallel to the top of Red Star Ridge. Then proceed southwesterly along Red Star Ridge to Mosquito Ridge Road. Then proceed easterly along Mosquito Ridge Road to the section corner common to Sections 25, 26, 35, and 36, T. 15 N., R. 13 E., MDM. Then proceed southerly to the point of beginning.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261.
