



PUBLIC NOTICE
Tahoe National Forest
North Fork Restricted Use Area
ORDER NO. 17-95-174

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Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), I prohibit all of the following acts on National Forest lands within the North Fork Restricted Use Area as shown on Exhibit 1:

1. Discharging firearms, air rifles, or gas guns. 36 CFR 261.58(m).
2. Possess or operate vehicles off forest development roads. 36 CFR 261.56.

The exterior boundaries of the North Fork Restricted Use Area as shown on Exhibit 1; generally described as:

Beginning on Forest Development Road 19 (Texas Hill Road) where it intersects with the "Old Bradley Ditch" (NE ¼, NE ¼, Sec. 7, T. 16N., R. 12E., MDM.). Proceed easterly along the "Old Bradley Ditch" to Onion Valley, where it intersects with Forest Road 45-1. Then southerly on 45-1 to its intersection with Forest Road 45. Then westerly on Road 45 to its intersection with Forest Road 19. Then northerly on Road 19 to its intersection with Forest Road 19-19. Then westerly on Road 19-19 to its intersection with Forest Road 19-19-1. Then westerly on Road 19-19-1 for ½ mile. Then proceed west across the North Fork of the North Fork of the American River and intersect with Forest Road 19. Then northeasterly on Road 19 to the point of the beginning.

The following persons are exempt:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit issued by the District Ranger. This permit must be in possession at all times while in the closed area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261.
