Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), I prohibit all of the following acts on National Forest lands outside of developed or designated recreation sites in the Fuller Lake Restricted Use Area as shown on Exhibit 1:

1. Camping. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

The Fuller Lake Restricted Use Area is generally described as:

The National Forest lands east of Fuller Lake, located in the SW ¼, SE ¼, Sec. 8, T.17N., R.12E., MDM., and the National Forest lands within ¼ mile of the west shore of Fuller Lake, located in the S ½, SW ¼, Sec. 8, T.17N., R.12E., MDM., as shown on Exhibit 1.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261.
