BIG HOLE MOUNTAINS SUBSECTION SUMMER TRAVEL MAP**

**Travel Restrictions
Big Hole Mountains Subsection**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System area, roads, and trails as described in this order, all within the Big Hole Mountains Subsection of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest as shown on the Big Hole Mountains Subsection Revised Summer Travel Map dated March 2008, until further notice.

1. Using any type of vehicle on National Forest System roads in violation of restrictions specified on the Revised Summer Travel Map dated March 2008. **36 CFR 261.54(a)**
2. Using any type of vehicle on National Forest System trails in violation of restrictions specified on the Revised Summer Travel Map dated March 2008 on the Caribou-Targhee National Forest. **36 CFR 261.55(b)**
3. Possessing or using any type of vehicle, including mountain bikes (two or three wheeled) off National Forest System roads and trails in violation of restrictions specified on the Revised Summer Travel Map dated March 2008 on the Caribou-Targhee National Forest. **36 CFR 261.56**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Forest Service administrative and project personnel engaged in an official duty.
3. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The entire area, including all roads and trails, within the Big Hole Mountains Subsection of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest as shown on the Revised Summer Travel Map dated March, 2008.

PURPOSE:

To provide for safe motorized travel, protect natural resources (physical and biological), separate recreation opportunities (motorized and non-motorized) and to minimize user conflicts.

Definition:

Vehicle means any device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported, including any frame, chassis, or body of any motor vehicle, except devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the trails is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders for the above-described trails.
