

R2 Sensitive Species List Recommendation

Great Basin Spadefoot (*Spea intermontana*)

Recommendation: Not R2 SS; not of concern

Rationale: Widespread and generally secure in the western United States. In R2, found broadly in northwestern Colorado and southwestern and central Wyoming. Little potential for occurring on NFS lands, but could occur on low elevations of the Medicine-Bow NF. Regardless, the species appears to be widespread and common within suitable, and its habitat relatively stable and secure. Therefore, we see no basis for conferring special management status to this species.
