

Timber Sale Logging Trucks on Forest Roads

Be aware that log trucks will be transiting forest roads this winter while travelling to and from logging operations on the forest. The roads being kept passable for the log trucks are not plowed to a width which would allow safe parking of vehicles or trailers. Snowmobiles should not travel on these roads until timber harvesting is complete.
