

Water Element

-  Wilderness:
-  Perennial Stream: One which flows continuously and has a designated riparian zone 200 feet wide.
-  Flood Plain: A lowland and relatively flat area adjoining a stream including, at a minimum, that area subject to a one percent (100 year recurrence) or greater chance of flooding in any given year.
-  Wetland: Land where the water table is at, near, or above the land surface long enough to promote the formation of hydric soils or to support the growth of hydrophytes.
-  Other Ownership: Includes private land and lakes.
