

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: American Woodcock

Scientific Name: *Scolopax minor*

Recommendation: Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendation Rationale:

This is a widespread species that is rated as globally secure (G5). In R2 the American Woodcock occurs on the far western periphery of its range. It is common in extreme eastern South Dakota and less common in eastern Nebraska and Kansas. The species does not get any further west than Grand Island, NE. Because of this very limited geographic distribution in the eastern portion of R2, it is not expected that viable populations of this woodcock would occur naturally on R2 administered lands and thus is not expected to be a management issue.
