

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Calliope Hummingbird

Scientific Name: *Stellula calliope*

Recommendation: Not R2 SS and not of concern

Recommendation Rationale:

R2 is on the extreme eastern periphery of the breeding range for this species, and contains only a small fraction of the total global breeding population. This species is a common summer resident in northwestern Wyoming and a rare to uncommon visitor to other parts of the region. The Calliope Hummingbird nests in riparian thickets and high mountain meadows throughout their range. Although no population or habitat trend information was available for R2, there is no reason to suspect a population decline, and no threats related to management of NFS lands were identified. Therefore Sensitive Species status does not appear to be warranted.
