

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Scott's Oriole

Scientific Name: *Icterus parisorum*

Recommendation: Not R2 SS and not of concern

Recommendation Rationale:

R2 is at the periphery of the range of this species. In Colorado, this species occurs west of Grand Junction near Towaoc on Ute Mountain, and south of La Junta; possibly occurs on Comanche NG. Habitat is piñon/juniper woodland/scrub, and is probably stable. Although BBS data indicate downward population trend, this may be unreliable statistically. Because R2 is at the extreme periphery of its range and habitat appears to be stable, sensitive species status is not warranted for this species and there is no concern for viability in R2.
