

## Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### Recommendations and Evaluations

**Common Name:** Western Wood-Pewee

**Scientific Name:** *Contopus sordidulus*

**Recommendation:** Not R2 SS and not of concern

### Recommendation Rationale:

This species is widely distributed throughout western North America. A common summer resident and migrant in the western half of the region, occurs throughout R2 except in Kansas. Although BBS data suggest a downward population trend, habitat appears to be stable, and few perceived threats associated with management activities on NFS lands. There is no indication of a viability concern for the species in R2.
