### **Colorado Recreation Resource Advisory Committee Meeting**

**DENVER, Colo., June 12, 2008** – The Colorado Recreation Resource Advisory Committee (Recreation RAC) will convene for its next meeting in Denver on June 24, 2008. The Recreation RAC was established as part of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide recommendations on fee proposals for the US Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management in Colorado.

Recreation RAC members were selected among applicants to represent 11 interests to include motorized, non-motorized, environmental, Indian tribes, local government and others from throughout the state.

The meeting will be devoted to reviewing the following topics and fee proposals:

- Briefing on general public support
- Colorado Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan update
- Historic cabins as recreation rentals
- Rio Grande cabins
- San Isabel cabins
- Grand Mesa cabins
- Uncompahgre cabins
- Arapaho National Recreation Area fee change
- Green Mountain Reservoir fee change

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be held at the American Mountaineering Center (AMC) at 710 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Golden, Colorado.

Members of the public interested in federal lands recreation issues and fees in Colorado may attend. General comments will be entertained from approximately 9:10 a.m. to 9:35 a.m. Comments may be taken during discussions on specific topics at the discretion of the Chair. Registration for the comment period will be required at the door.
