

SPECIAL CLOSURE  
BARTLETT ENDANGERED SPECIES AREA

TONTO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following restrictions are established within the area indicated on the map below: located in portions of section 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, T. 5 N., R. 7 E.:

It is prohibited to go into or be upon this area from December 1 through June 30 annually. 261.53(a)

This restriction does not apply to persons in a watercraft floating down the Verde River, provided they do not stop.

Vehicular entry into this area is prohibited yearlong. 261.53(a)


These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36 CFR 261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with written authorization by a Forest Officer authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This closure supercedes order 12-29R dated December 10, 1986.
