**Order 11-01**

**Forest Order**

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Roads and Trails within a portion of the Salida Ranger District on the San Isabel National Forest, Chaffee County, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area.

The Restricted Area is further defined as being within the Fourmile Travel Management Area (Fourmile Area) located on the Salida Ranger District, Chaffee County, Colorado.

The affected routes/route segments within the Restricted Area are described below:

The Restricted Area is shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as "Exhibit A", identifying specific seasonal gate locations and route closures. This Order is necessary to protect big game winter range habitat and limit excessive mud season wear and tear on specific full-sized vehicle roads and Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) system trails in the Restricted Area.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Using any motorized vehicle on those portions of the National Forest System Roads listed above from midnight of December 1 of each year through midnight of April 15 of the following year.  
36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a).
2. Using any motorized vehicle on those portions of the National Forest System Trails listed above from midnight of December 1 of each year through midnight of April 15 of the following year.  
36 C.F.R. § 261.55(b).

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- Persons operating over-the-snow vehicles within the Restricted Area, when the Restricted Area roads and trails have at least six (6) measurable inches of snow cover.
- Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- Residents or holders of special use authorizations within the Restricted Area currently serviced by the above listed closed roads and trails, requiring motorized access to their property or facilities (e.g., Goddard Ranch and the cities of Aurora and Colorado Springs - Homestake Pipeline).
- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This Order shall be in effect upon signature, and remain in effect until rescinded, or through midnight of April 15, 2015.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
