

ORDER NO. 04-10-03
INYO NATIONAL FOREST

USE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within portions of the John Muir and Ansel Adams Wilderness Areas, as shown on Exhibit A. This Order is effective from May 19, 2010, through June 30, 2010.

Grazing of pack stock animals, including horses, mules, donkeys, and llamas, above 7,000 feet in elevation. 36 CFR 261.57(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within portions of the John Muir and Ansel Adams Wilderness Areas, as shown on Exhibit A. This Order is effective from July 1, 2010, through July 14, 2010.

Grazing of pack stock animals, including horses, mules, donkeys, and llamas, above 8,000 feet in elevation. 36 CFR 261.57(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within portions of the John Muir and Ansel Adams Wilderness Areas, as shown on Exhibit A. This Order is effective from July 15, 2010, through July 31, 2010.

Grazing of pack stock animals, including horses, mules, donkeys, and llamas, above 9,000 feet in elevation. 36 CFR 261.57(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

Grazing of pack stock animals, including horses, mules, donkeys, and llamas, above 10,000 feet in elevation. 36 CFR 261.57(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.




Exhibit A: Inyo National Forest Grazing Restrictions


Exhibit A: Inyo National Forest Grazing Restrictions
