SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR SUGARLOAF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROAD 402

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the areas and roads as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area"), all within the Mesa Ranger District, Tonto National Forest, Maricopa County, Arizona:

1. Going into or being upon an area, Public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53e

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any Royden Construction employee or contractor being contracted by the Arizona Department of Transportation while engaged in official duties.

AREA DESCRIBED

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands and roads starting from the intersection of Highway 87 and Forest Development Road 402, following the roadway northwest for 1 mile encompassing 300 feet along both sides of the roadbed as depicted in Exhibit A. Sugarloaf Road (FDR 402), is located on the Mesa Ranger District of Tonto National Forest (T4N, R8E, Section 23, NW).

PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is the protection of National Forest visitors, employees and contractors, the prevention of user conflicts, the conservation of natural resources, and the protection of property belonging to the United States.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. Prohibitions contained in this order become effective beginning Monday, January 24, 2011, and will remain in effect until Friday, January 28, 2011. Restrictions are in effect during daylight periods (05:00-18:00), unless terminated sooner.
2. These restrictions are in addition to the general prohibitions found at 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

3. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
