### **Cleveland National Forest Use Restriction Level: Low**

**San Diego, CA** –January 4, 2011...The recent rainfall in the region has helped minimize the fire danger level on the Forest, reducing the Forest Use Restriction level from **HIGH** to **LOW**. Forest use restrictions implemented during **HIGH** will be lifted effective Wednesday, January 5, 2011 at 6:00 a.m.

“We appreciate the public’s cooperation, and visitors should still use care and caution when visiting the Forest,” said Will Metz, Forest Supervisor for the Cleveland National Forest.

Forest visitors can check on road access, allowable recreational activities, and what restrictions are in place by going to the forest website, [www.fs.fed.us/r5/cleveland](http://www.fs.fed.us/r5/cleveland) and clicking on “current conditions” or by calling the nearest District Office. For a recorded message please call **619-593-2183**. Please check with the other southern California National Forests to determine what current fire restrictions are in place.
