

4FRI Workshop Update: Additional time added for Feb. 9 workshop in Williams

A 4FRI workshop is scheduled for Wednesday, Feb. 9, from 1 to 5 p.m. in Williams. That workshop will continue as planned. However, we have now added an additional session for that same day for individuals who would like a more detailed review of firescapes 1 and 2.

The previously scheduled workshop will begin at 1 p.m. that same day. From 1 to 1:30 p.m., there will be an introduction to 4FRI. For the remainder of the afternoon, information will be provided on existing and desired conditions and potential treatments for firescapes 3 and 4.

Both sessions on Feb. 9 will be held at the Williams Ranger District, Kaibab National Forest, 742 S. Clover Rd., Williams, Ariz. Firescape 1 is generally located south of I-40 and east of I-17. Firescape 2 is generally located west of I-17 and south of the Mogollon Rim. Firescape 3, which includes portions of the Williams district (Kaibab National Forest), Flagstaff and Red Rock districts (Coconino National Forest), is generally located south of I-40 and west of I-17. Firescape 4 includes portions of the Flagstaff district (Coconino National Forest) and the Williams district (Kaibab National Forest). It is generally located north of I-40 and west of Highway 180.
