

# ORDER NO 327

## UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

### Cherokee National Forest

#### Recreation Restriction

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act or omission is prohibited on McKamey Lake on the Ocoee/Hiwassee District, Indian Boundary Lake on the Tellico District, and Allen Branch Pond located on the Nolichucky/Unaka District, all within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map.

1. Possessing or operating a motorboat powered by an internal combustion engine. **36 CFR 261.58(n)**

**The above-prohibited act is set forth in Title 36 C.F.R. Section 261.58**

**Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:**

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

#### **ORDER EXPIRES FIVE YEARS FROM DATE OF SIGNATURE**

Violation of the prohibitions set forth above is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
