UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Cherokee National Forest

Developed Recreation Area Restriction

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Watauga District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map.

1. Camping 36 CFR 261.58(e)

Areas Affected By This Order

Y's Men Fishing Access
Little Milligan Boating Site
Watauga Point

Sink Mountain Boating Site
Rat Branch Boating Site
Shook Branch

Point of land approximately 500 feet due south of the Little Oak Recreation Area Boating Site.

The above-prohibited act is set forth in Title 36 C.F.R. Section 261.58

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
