



Scotia-Marcoot Spring Walk-in Turkey Area

The Scotia-Marcoot Walk-in Area is bounded by Highway 72 to the East, Forest Road 2340 to the South, and Private Lands to the West and North. The Walk-in Area is Approximately 4,037 Acres.
