Description: Leaves are alternate and twice divided into narrow, toothed segments. Flat-topped clusters of yellow “button” flowers, composed of disk florets only, no petals.

Crimes committed: Prolific seed producer, but can also reproduce from rootstalks. Rootstalks are long, woody, and hard to kill. Livestock find it unpalatable or even toxic.
