

Indian Boundary Campground

Located in the Indian Boundary Recreation Area and two miles off the Cherohala Skyway, Indian Boundary Campground offers 87 sites with electric hookups. The overflow area has 38 additional sites without electricity. All sites accommodate RVs or tents. Multiple bathhouses, a seasonal camp store, and a RV dump station are located in the campground.

The campground is open from mid-April through the end of October. The overflow area remains open during winter with limited amenities.

The 96-acre Indian Boundary Lake offers a swim area, fishing opportunities, and a 3-mile lakeside trail for hiking and biking. Boats are allowed, but gasoline motors are not.

Reservations are recommended for this campground. Call (877) 444-6777 or on line at www.recreation.gov.

While in the area, visit Bald River falls, a 90-foot waterfall you can view from Forest Road 210.

Directions: From Highway 68 in Tellico Plains, take TN 165 east for 16 miles. Turn left onto Forest Road 345 and travel 2 miles to campground entrance.

Site Amenities: Loops A, B, C and D offer RV and tent sites with electric hookups. Picnic tables, grills, and lantern posts are located at each site. Water hydrants are located throughout the campground. Bathhouses provide flush toilets and warm showers. The day-use area includes Indian Boundary Lake, a boat launch, swim area with sand beach, two volleyball courts, a picnic area, and bathhouse.

Requirements: Please limit occupancy to five people per campsite. Only two vehicles are allowed per campsite.

Campsites Fees: Campsite without electric hook-ups - \$10/site/day (\$10/sites located in Overflow Campground only)
Campsite with electric hook-ups - \$20/site/day

Day-Use Area Fee is \$3/day/car. Permit must be visibly displayed in car. Camping receipt serves as day-use area permit.

PASSES: Fees with an America the Beautiful or Golden Pass are: \$10/site = \$5 w/pass; \$20/site = \$15 w/pass; \$3.00 day-use fee = \$1.50 w/pass.

-Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 6 am.

-No fish or dish cleaning at water hydrants.

Safety: The following rules are in place for visitor safety:

-All food or refuse must be properly stored or disposed of in a bear proof container. You cannot leave food or trash out unless you are preparing, eating, or discarding it.

-Campfires are permitted in grills only, do not leave fires unattended.

-Pets must be on a leash and are not allowed on the beach.

-Discharging firearms and fireworks is not permitted.

-No lifeguards on duty, swim at your own risk.

-Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
