Directions: From Westminster, drive west 7.5 miles on US Highway 76 and turn right onto Cobb Bridge Road (Oconee County S-37). Drive 1.6 miles; turn left onto Spy Rock Road (FS 748, graveled). Drive 1.8 miles to FS 748C (on the right) and park by the side of the road. Hike east on FS 748C for 0.3 miles to the trail and hike 0.7 miles to the waterfall.

Camping: Primitive camping is allowed along the trail, but campsites must be more than 50 feet from streams and trails, and more than 0.25 miles from roads.

Difficulty level: Moderate

Height: 12 feet




Length of hike: One mile

Hiking travel time: 45 minutes (one way)
