## Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee to Meet February 28 at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office

**YREKA, CA.**—The Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) will meet on February 28, 2011 at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1312 Fairlane Road, Yreka, CA. The meeting will begin at 4:00 p.m. and usually ends before 8:00 p.m. The public is invited to attend and make comment.

The best access to the RAC Meeting is through the rear door of the office, located on Mill Street, where there is ample parking.

The RAC is federally sanctioned by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture and was formed as a result of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000. The RAC is a local advisory committee that recommends projects to federal land managers which will benefit resources on public lands. The fifteen member group represents a cross section of county communities, industries, schools, environmentalists, and local government.

The agenda includes project updates and financial status, public comment period, and review of new project proposals to be considered by the RAC. Submissions for project proposals are still being accepted. Applications received by the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month will be reviewed at that month's meeting. There are approximately a half million dollars yet to be awarded for new project proposals. Projects selected this year may be implemented in 2012.
