



ORDER NO.2007-13

**ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR  
RESTRICTING FIRES, TO WIT:  
GREAT GULF WILDERNESS AREA  
WHITE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL FOREST – NEW HAMPSHIRE and MAINE**

Under the authority of the Act of Congress dated June 4, 1897, as amended (16 U.S.C. 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth as 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts and omissions are prohibited in the Great Gulf Wilderness Area, Coos County, New Hampshire, said area being described and designated as shown on the map set forth at Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereto:

- 1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire EXCEPT camp stoves using candles, pressurized liquid or gas, or other manufactured fuels. (36 CFR 261.52(a))**
- 2. Camping within ¼ mile of the Great Gulf Trail from the intersection with the Sphinx Trail to the Intersection with the Gulfside Trail EXCEPT at designated sites. (36 CFR 261.58(e))**
- 3. CFR Camping within 200 feet of any trail EXCEPT at designated sites. (36 261.58(e))**

**THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THE PROHIBITION WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL SPECIFICALLY WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.**

Pursuant to the provisions of 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)); and,
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR 261.50(e)(4));

**Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C., 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).**
