AMENDMENT NO. 9

Flaming Gorge National Recreation Area - Land Exchange

September 6, 1991

The analysis to support this change in the Forest Plan supplemental direction for the Flaming Gorge National Recreation Area is documented in a decision memo signed by Duane Tucker, Ashley National Forest Supervisor dated September 5, 1991.

LANDOWNERSHIP ADJUSTMENT - In Appendix A-22, under 6. Landownership Adjustments and Land Controls, in paragraph (1) after the words, ". . . where non-conforming and conflicting private land uses occur or are imminent," insert the following language:

Utilize land exchange to modify the landownership pattern to meet management objectives consistent with the intent and goals of the National Recreation Area; for example, evaluate proposals for a land exchange to privatize the Dutch John townsite and surrounding lands.
