




Daniel Boone NATIONAL FOREST



The Daniel Boone National Forest consists of over 707,000 acres within a 2.1-million acre proclamation boundary. Ownership is highly fragmented with private lands. The areas in green indicate areas managed by the Forest Service. The black line indicates the 2.1 million-acre proclamation boundary.
