PUBLIC SAFETY CLOSURE
TERMINATION ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), all prohibitions listed in Order Number 12-10-249, affecting areas on National Forest System lands, roads and trails identified as the restricted area which includes all National Forest System lands and roads within the boundary of the Needle Rock Beach and Day Use Recreation sites, and Forest Development Road 20 from Midway Wash north to its terminus vicinity of FDR 2117 on Tonto National Forest, as depicted in Exhibit A of this Order.

The boundary of the closure boundary is described as follows: Starting on the East side of FDR 20 just north of Midway Wash, and proceeding north to the southernmost entrance to Needle Rock Day Use site (FDR 2038) then easterly to the western edge of the Verde River surface flow, then northerly and westerly to the rock outcropping approximately 75 yards north of FDR 413 (Camp Creek Wash), then south across FDR 413 and continuing southerly along the western edge of FDR 20 to the northern edge of Midway Wash and easterly across FDR 20 to the starting point, within the Cave Creek Ranger District of the Tonto National Forest, Arizona, dated September 27, 2010 and signed by Gene Blankenbaker are hereby rescinded and terminated; effective 8:00 AM, Friday, February 25, 2011.
