

## Superior National Forest Summer Seasonal Archaeological Technician (Wilderness)

The Superior National Forest is looking to hire two seasonal archaeologist based out of the Supervisor's Office in Duluth, Minnesota. The incumbent will be integrated into wilderness work crews, and extended work details in the Boundary Waters Wilderness Canoe Area are expected. The expected work assignments for these positions will include providing on-site archaeological survey and project design support to wilderness field crews conducting ground-disturbing projects at remote campsite and portage locations in the 1 million acre wilderness (70%). Direct support of soil stabilization projects and/or noxious weed treatments (30%) is also expected. Incumbent should expect 6-8 day work details, with 4-6 days off per 2-week pay period. Conditions of employment include physically demanding work conditions such as rain, bugs, humidity, hiking, and up to 10 miles of paddling and portaging a day. This position will be filled at the GS-5 (\$15.00/hr) level. The position will run from approximately mid May-Sept. Government housing may be available at Grand Marais and/or Ely, Minnesota. Candidates that have completed an archaeological field school, have coursework and or field experience in Midwestern archaeology, and have prior backcountry experience are strongly encouraged to apply.

**Student Hiring Procedure:** Send or email listing locations interested in and availability to the address/fax/email listed below. You will be required to provide a current copy of your resume and official transcripts if considered. You must be enrolled as a full-time student the ensuing academic year to be considered as a student hire.

**Non-Student Hiring Procedures:** To be considered, **you must apply for the position using the national on-line government application process, AVUE Hiring System.** You must ensure that you indicate the appropriate work location in AVUE to ensure that you show up on the correct referral list. **Upon Selection to a Position:**

If you are hired you will need to bring with you a copy of your Social Security Card and Drivers License – OR – a copy of your passport; along with all completed hiring forms.

Employees are issued a government drivers license after receiving defensive driving instruction and taking a written examination and road test. In order to be issued a government drivers license you must:

- Have a valid State driver's license; this is also a requirement to work for the FS.
- Bring a copy of your state driving record from your state's department of motor vehicles (~\$5) along with your completed hiring forms. You must have a driving record free of major infractions.

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
