Klamath and Modoc National Forests 2011 Off-Highway Grant Application for Law Enforcement

The Klamath and Modoc national forests are developing an application for Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) cooperative funds for the 2011 grant cycle. The preliminary application to the Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division will request funds for the purchase of video camera equipment for law enforcement needs.

The 30 day public review and comment period for the 2011 Grants and Cooperative Agreement Program begins on March 6th, 2011, and ends April 4th, 2011. Please ensure that you submit any comments prior to April 4th, 2011 to ensure they receive consideration. This provides an opportunity for the public to review the preliminary applications submitted to the OHMVR Division during the current grant cycle.
